



Painted Post Field and Stream *Range Rules*

General Rules (Outdoor and Indoor Ranges):

- Members and guests only
- Eye and Ear protection is **MANDATORY!**
- Sign in and out using the provided books
- When two or more people are using the range, one will act as the range officer
 - Range officer will:
 - Insure all firearms are empty and safe before people go down range
 - Make sure no one is down range before allowing shooting to begin
 - Coordinate with other shooters when to go down range to hang or check targets
 - Remind other shooters there will be no careless handling of firearms
 - The decisions of the acting range officer are final
- All shooting must be straight down range, No Crossfire!
- No full automatic or simulated full automatic allowed
- Pick Up After yourself
 - Take down targets when finished shooting, keep the range clean
 - Pick up empty cartridges and cases, etc.
 - Dispose of Any trash in appropriate receptacles

Indoor Rifle Range:

- **NO Firearms Closer than 50ft**
 - All shooting must be done at the 50ft Line, No Closer
- Firearm Restrictions
 - NO shotguns
 - NO Rifles above 22 caliber
 - NO Black Powder firearms
 - NO .17 Caliber firearms
- Ammunition Restrictions
 - NO jacketed bullets
 - NO magnum ammunition, including 22 magnum
 - Use only target velocity ammunition, below 1000 feet per second
- Keep shots within the outlined target area
- Rope barrier must be up when range is hot.

Outdoor Rifle Range:

- Shooting Hours are 9:00am until Dusk
 - Special Events may close the rifle range at other times. Please see the monthly newsletter or website for details
 - Observe Range Closed Signs
- Minimum distance for metal swingers is 50 meters. Leave swingers in center of range
- Keep targets low enough to allow bullets to hit the dirt berms
- No glass targets
- **NO exploding targets**
